## **BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

Govt. Arts and Science College, Kondotty, a government college affiliated to the University of Calicut, was started in 2013. The college offers five degree programs namely BA Functional English, BSc Mathematics, BA Urdu, BTHM and BCom and two PG programmes namely MA English and MSc Mathematics. The college had a humble beginning in 2013. It started functioning in the building of Madharul-Uloom Higher Secondary Madrasa, Cheriya-paramb Vilayil. Within two years, the college shifted to a semi-permanent building in the campus. By 2019, the college shifted to a full-fledged permanent building with all facilities like office, departments, library, labs, classrooms, washrooms and so on. By 2020, a compound wall and gate were constructed. The college which began as a UG college was upgraded to a PG college in 2018 with two PG programmes. Most of the aims of the strategic plan envisioned by the college for the period 2015-2020 have been achieved. At present there are 631 students, 34 teaching faculty members and 12 non teaching staff. The college is functioning in its own campus with all necessary infrastructural facilities.

### **Academics:**

Currently there are five major departments and seven allied departments. There are 34 faculty members in various departments. Out of the twelve departments, two offer postgraduate programmes.
